

Genetics of transporters: a population-based perspective for non-specialists

Description	The course aims at providing participants with basic knowledge in statistical genetics, causal inference, epidemiologic study designs and public health genomics, with a focus on transporters. Areas such as nutrigenomics, pharmacogenomics and evolutionary medicine will be covered. Participants will be asked to actively contribute to discussions and bring-in their own expertise and perspective on the public health utility of selected recent discoveries.
Eligibility	The course is open to PhD students and Postdocs.
Course structure	The course will include oral presentations and interactive group works.
