

## NCCR TransCure Young Scientist Award – Guidelines 2018

Since fall 2016, the NCCR TransCure has a call for **NCCR TransCure Young Scientist Awards**. With these awards, two research proposals from advanced female PhD students or postdoctoral researchers, working within NCCR TransCure, will be funded. Preference is given to proposals that ensure for an additional benefit to an existing NCCR TransCure project. The two best proposals will be awarded with CHF 9'000 for small pieces of equipment, consumables and/or travel expenses for specific congresses or events within the research field and CHF 1'000 as personal money.

### → **Requirements overview for the 2018 Awards:**

- Candidates are *female* researchers that are either employed by or associated to NCCR TransCure. (advanced PhD students, more than 2 years, and postdoctoral fellows)
- The maximum funding per proposal is CHF 9'000 + CHF 1'000 as personal money.
- Only one proposal per PI is allowed.
- NCCR TransCure Award can fund small pieces of equipment, consumables and/or travel expenses. Applications need to include a max. 3-page CV, a max. 2-page proposal and a 1-page budget plan, (all in single file - pdf format).
- A short statement of the NCCR TransCure PI that he/she approves the proposal and will acknowledge the NCCR TransCure Young Scientist Award in related publications (if applicable) needs to be included.
- Each project proposal can only be submitted once, winners of the previous year can submit a new proposal in 2018.
